Recently, due to the many refugee families in our community, they have been spearheading a ministry to help these families settle and get established. We have participated with Marc and Kim in several of their initiatives including the Welcome House.

This week our study for “The Bible and Racial Reconciliation” is on “The Great Multitude” from Revelation 7:9-17. I can think of no one better than Marc and Kim to lead this session as look at the beautiful picture of heaven where people of every nation, tribe, peoples and languages stand before the throne of God in worship. Come join us at 6:00 p.m. for this study as Marc and Kim lead us. We meet in Room A214.

The final night of our study will be on April 2 and we will be meeting at 5:00 p.m. that evening. On our final evening we will have testimonies and discussion with four families in our church that will share their experience of being a part of Trinity Baptist as either an interracial couple or an African American family. Celebrating Easter WITH GRADE SCHOOL CHILDREN

We are Easter people! Joy and hope characterize our lives because Jesus rose from the grave that first Easter morning. Beginning with Palm Sunday (Holy Week), we prepare for the greatest church festival of all---The Resurrection of Our Lord.

This season is a meaningful time for families to be together. Here are some suggestions to guide you with your children.

Define Easter

Holy Week: the week from Palm Sunday to Easter—a week that begins and ends in triumph and rejoicing.

Palm Sunday: we celebrate Jesus' triumphant arrival in Jerusalem.

Maundy Thursday: Remembering the Passover and last supper

Good Friday: Remembering the day Jesus was crucified.

Easter Sunday: Celebrate Jesus' resurrection.

Prepare for the week by discussing and planning activities, which can help each family member focus on the significance of Easter.

Have a family devotional time and make a visual. Try these

Easter Symbol Tree

1. Take a dead branch or small bush.
2. Paint it white if you wish.
3. Set it in a coffee can 2/3's full of cement, sand or plaster of Paris.
4. Talk about items that represent Jesus, Easter and his ministry. (cross, lily, loaf of bread, fish, shepherd's crook, Bible, palm leaf, etc.)
5. Allow each person to draw or construct a symbol out of paper to hang on the tree.

Create A Crown of Thorns Wreath

1. Purchase a grapevine wreath to use as a base.
2. Insert seven purple candles in the wreath, one for each night of the week, and a white candle to represent Christ.

3. Light one candle for the first night, light two candles for the second night, and so on.
4. Light the Christ candle on Saturday as you celebrate the joyous resurrection tomorrow.

Celebrate!

Daily remind family members that God loves them. Communicate the many ways that God loves your family. Talk about the physical needs God provides like food, shelter, clothing, and water. Discuss how God provides for everyone in the world. Use this time to discuss being sorry for wrong choices and mention how saying "I'm sorry" is the first step to making a situation right. Add the importance of forgiving the person who has wronged you. Explain how God does that with us every time we pray to Him about our sins.

Attend Sunday School and hear the story with fellow Christians.

Attend a sunrise service.

God loved! God gave! Jesus Loves us all!
