We have been helping the Santa Elena Baptist Church build a Primary School for the past 5 years. The classrooms are finished. Almost 200 children are attending now, and two more classrooms will open in September for preschoolers. There is one building left to build...an open-air "auditorium" where the whole school can come together for programs. This building will also enable Pastor Manny Cowo to hold evening worship services on the school grounds – making every effort to reach the families of the children attending the school for Christ.

Join the college-student-through-adult team that will be doing the block construction of a low wall and support columns that will hold the roof (to be added later). Cost of the trip including airfare, lodging, meals, ground transportation, water taxi, t-shirt and insurance will be around \$1,400 (adjustable for air fare rates).

Airline tickets must be purchased by the end of May. So please go ahead and sign up and pay the \$250 deposit (included in the total cost) to Rev. Melton.
