way to study the Bible and also build fellowship with other Christian men and women. You are encouraged to also share this opportunity and bring friends and co-workers with you.

Our Pastor's Bible Study will be a different approach to Mark's gospel. I will be leading this study and it is a combination of lecture and discussion. One of the benefits of studying the same material as TNT on Wednesday is to allow those who need child care to be able to study along with others. With our Wednesday night programs for children and youth, we can all be a part of the study this fall. If you attend TNT, the Pastor's Bible Study may also be beneficial, as it will be a different format with a more intensive nature. I often hear people comment that they would really like to engage in an intensive Bible Study. That is our plan for the Wednesday night format.

In addition to these Bible Study opportunities, we will also be hosting our "Being the Presence of Christ" series on Sunday evenings beginning September 10. 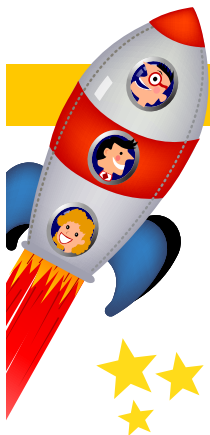
