## Advent

For over a thousand years Christians have celebrated the weeks preceding Christmas as "ADVENT." Advent means "coming" and refers to a period of preparation for the birth of Jesus. In Christian tradition it is a time of penitence and of spiritual searching so that all will be prepared to receive the Christ Child into their hearts and lives.

Christmas is a whole season, not just a day. Advent can be a very long time for children who see, hear, and feel all the preparation going on around them. They can do little to participate, and since the very young have little concept of time, the waiting is not easy. Using an Advent calendar is a fun way to help a young child, or any of us, to count the days until Christmas and ease the impatience.

The simplest and most visual form of Advent calendar for the very young is a colored paper chain that has rings for every day in Advent. As the child removes one ring each day, he or she can see that Christmas is coming nearer. When the whole chain is gone, Christmas Day will have arrived.

Advent materials for children and their families will be available in various areas of our church. Plan to make this advent special as you share together the meaning and hope of the season. Stop by and select a calendar or special book for your family.

- Tell Bible stories in creative ways – use plastic/wooden figures and draw or act them out.
- When you tell a Bible story, talk about what the people might have felt and what you can learn from them.
- Make application points relevant to your child's experience. For example, little ones understand feeling afraid, impatient, and selfish.
- When you memorize a Bible verse together, make up hand motions or a catchy rhythm.
- If possible, connect a tactile experience with a Bible story or application point. For example, feel water when you learn about the Israelites crossing the Red Sea or pick up stones when you read about David bravely facing Goliath.
