## **Joining Hands with God**

In the next few months, we will be making some important decisions as a congregation regarding our potential Capital Project "Deepen the Ties that Bind." There are two important activities that are occurring, which I want you to know about. First, we rescheduled our second Town Hall meeting date to this coming Sunday, February 14. The first session will be during our Sunday School hour. If you would like to attend the session to be informed and asked questions, we encourage you to go to your Sunday School class so they know you are here and then go to the Fellowship Hall for the one hour session which will begin at 9:45 a.m.

The second session will be that same afternoon at 5:00 p.m., prior to our Discipleship hour. You are encouraged to attend one of these sessions and be informed about the project and to ask questions and make suggestions to our committee.

In addition, there is a sub-committee that is hard at work planning a transition during the construction time if the church approves the construction project. This team is looking at the impact of construction on worship, Sunday School space, security, music, children and student activities, Sr. Adult activities, Recreation and the total ministry of the church. They will be presenting to the church a plan for transition during the construction time.

I am deeply appreciative to all of our leaders and committee members who are giving an enormous amount of time, energy and thought to this process. This is going to be an exciting year in the life of our church as we continue to discern God's direction for us.

We are excited to welcome Katie Medlin to our ministerial staff. Katie will begin on February 15. I would encourage you to send Katie a card and welcome her to our congregation. In addition, Rev. Tatum returns this week from her maternity leave. Lydia has been here on Wednesdays and Sundays during her leave to spend time with our students, but it will be great to have her back. I am pleased that as of next week, we will be back at full ministerial staff.

Finally, I hope you will join us on Sunday nights for "What the Bible Says About...?" We will be in the Chapel at 6:00 p.m. That week we will be looking at what the Bible has to say about marriage.

## Make way for Play!

Play is one of the most effective methods of teaching preschoolers. Some popular teaching methods involve the children in seeing or hearing the material only. Preschoolers, however, are active learners. They remember only 20% of what they hear, 30% of what they see, and 50% of what they see and hear at the same time. Yet, when young children go beyond merely seeing and hearing and are instead involved in an activity that allows them to talk and do, the amount they remember will increase to 90%.

Younger preschoolers at play are actively doing. Older preschoolers at play are actively talking and doing. Play is important and becomes one of the most effective teaching methods and learning experiences available to preschool teachers and parents. A good thing to remember and ponder is that preschoolers who are sitting very still and keeping very quiet are not necessarily learning their best.

Play incorporates seven main avenues of learning. These include relationships, senses, imitation, curiosity, experiences, satisfaction, and repetition. Children involved in loving, faithful relationships with others learn the element of trust. The senses provide an excellent avenue for preschoolers to learn about God and the world God made.

A child's first experience with prayer, helpfulness, thankfulness, and kindness often rely heavily on imitation. Which should make us ever mindful of the examples we set. Repetition builds preschoolers' sense of independence and confidence. The child's curiosity leads to exploration, and exploration sometimes results in worship. And if learning about God is a satisfying experience, it creates a desire for continued learning.

So play is important. Play is necessary. Play creates an environment for learning. And play can lead into worship. A preschooler who senses the wonder of God's creation, who is awed by the story of Jesus healing the blind man, or who chooses to express his idea about God through art ....is worshipping. Make way for Play!
