This coming Saturday afternoon at 1:00 p.m. you will have the opportunity to meet with our Facilities Master Planning Committee for a “visual walk through” of our proposed building project. We will meet in the sanctuary and the team will walk through the project in the Sanctuary, Narthex and Courtyard to help us visualize the proposed building and changes. I hope you will take advantage of this opportunity to gain information and insight. The team will answer any questions you might have concerning the project.

Our Facilities and Master Planning Committee is hard at work finalizing the cost of the project with Clancey and Theys. Once the price becomes a bid for the project, we will be planning a “major church event” vote on moving forward with construction. In addition, we have a transition team developing a strategy for worship, education and activities during the construction period. They are developing the budget and plan to allow us, as a congregation, to continue our worship, activities and Sunday School. I am grateful for all who are working so hard on this project. They will be presenting their plan to the Trustees and then to the church in the near future. We will inform you once that time is set.

As we continue toward this important date in our church’s future, I want to encourage you to be in prayer and also to continue to be informed about the project. I want to remind us that this project is about our congregation and our values. This project will undergird our value of worship by creating more space and enhancing our worship experience. It will address our need for fellowship. Sunday morning is increasingly becoming the one time a week when we see each other and interact. An
