## Joining Hands with God

“Et tu, Brute?” Those famous words of Shakespeare remind us of the pain of betrayal. In the book “The Hunger Games” the author writes, “for there to be betrayal there had to be trust first.” Interestingly, we are drawn to stories of betrayal. They make interesting books, movies and plays. Some of the most popular television shows are based on the drama of betrayal. Recently, the creator of the real life drama “Survivor” said in an interview that “if you cannot lie you cannot play this game.” That may be true about the game “Survivor”, and I am afraid many believe that to be true about life in general. Betrayal may be an interesting plot for a drama whatever the genre, but it is not so interesting when it is real and it involves you and me.

The pain of betrayal is something that we all experience at some point in life. It might be the pain of a friend who disappoints us, a co-worker who used us, or when one of our heroes falls from their pedestal. Some of us have even known the pain of the betrayal of a spouse in some form or another. Betrayal ushers in feelings of grief, disappointment, anger and revenge. When we know we have been betrayed there is a sinking feeling that is hard for us to describe.

In the Bible there are moments of betrayal, but none stand out like the betrayal of Judas. Just the mention of Judas’ name causes us to have a negative reaction. Judas, one of Jesus’ chosen 12, would do the unimaginable. He would betray Jesus. Yet, there are other subtle moments of betrayal in Jesus’ story that we sometime miss.

As we continue our journey to the cross with Jesus, we are pausing to reflect on various moments in Jesus’ last week. This week, we pause in that moment between Gethsemane and the Calvary. This week we turn our attention to the moment of betrayal. How did Jesus respond? Do we betray Jesus as well? Do we find ourselves wondering like the others during the Last Supper “Is it I?”

I look forward to seeing you in worship as we continue our journey to the Easter. This week, we will explore the depth of betrayal of Jesus and our own experience with betrayal.
