This past Sunday night our Construction Team Chair for our Facilities Master Planning Committee, John Witcher, updated our congregation concerning their work. This team is working closely with our architect and our pre-construction engineers from Clancy and Theys to be able to present to our congregation a project that not only meets our expressed needs, but also honors our church's budget for our new expansion. Our Capital Campaign to raise 4 million dollars over four years was based on our best estimate of the project being 7 million dollars. A budget team from our congregation presented to the church a budget plan not to exceed 3 million in permanent loans and was approved. The construction committee is working with this budget as their guide as we move forward. Our new estimate exceeded our budget. Now our committee is working with our architect and our engineers to make some value decisions, so the committee can present to the congregation a project, which will provide for our needs and also honor our stated budget.

As a reminder the goals of the project have remained:

- An enlarged Narthex to enable fellowship, registration and welcoming of members and guests.
- An updated and enlarged Sanctuary, which will be more functional in regards to our worship needs, (i.e. chancel space, choir and orchestra space, and handicap accessibility) in all areas of the sanctuary and improved lighting and sound.
- Additional classroom space for Sunday School class growth.

The way forward will be for our construction team to continue its work, and then present the plan to the larger Facilities Master Planning Committee. Upon approval, the plan will be presented to the church for feedback, discussion and ultimately a vote of approval to proceed.

Giving Plans: Your Choice

Since 2010, Trinity has offered its members a choice of mission giving to either the NC Baptist State Convention, the Southern Baptist Convention, the NC Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, National Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, or Trinity Baptist missions.

Each year, the new budget includes an estimate of what we will give to each organization. This amount is a percentage of the undesignated offerings we receive. In addition, one half of one percent of undesignated offerings is given to the Raleigh Baptist Association.

Using the choice of designations shown on members' offering envelopes, the financial administrator applies a formula to calculate the amount of money to send to: the Raleigh Baptist Association, the NC Baptist State Convention – Southern Baptist Convention, and the NC Cooperative Baptist Fellowship - National CBF.

Several examples of support from each organization include:

NC Baptist State Convention: Baptist scholarships, Baptist Retirement Homes, Baptist Children's Homes, Baptist Hospital in Winston-Salem, and the Biblical Recorder

NC Cooperative Baptist Fellowship: Baptist supported colleges and universities in NC, plus scholarships to these schools, the Baptist Retirement Homes, Baptist Children's Homes, Women's Missionary Union, and the Baptist Men.

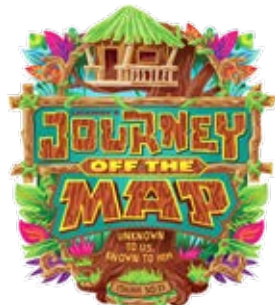
