I hope the season of Lent and now Easter at Trinity has been as meaningful to you as it has to me. Our weekly moments spent in the shadow of the cross has helped me to spend time reflecting on the cross and the forgiveness of our sins. Our actors and musicians were excellent in leading us each and every week. Easter was a glorious day of celebration from our Sunrise Service, through both of our worship services. What a thrill it was to see two very large crowds for worship, to baptize 7 new Christians and to worship our risen Lord.

The question we must ask after every Easter is "now what"? What are we to do knowing Jesus is alive? Jesus tells us. Jesus sends us into the world with this good news. We are to go from our place of worship into our community serving others, sharing the good news of Christ by word and deed. At Trinity there are so many ways for you to participate in being on mission. This month you can be on mission by giving, serving and even playing.

Be on mission by giving. We are continuing to receive our Home Missions Offering. This offering goes to support missionaries and missions which focus on North America through the Southern Baptist Convention and the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. As Baptists we make the choice of cooperation. As an autonomous church we are not required to give beyond our own ministries and programs, but we know that the Kingdom of God is larger than our little corner of North Hills in North Raleigh. We give to mission offerings to join others in ministry in ways and places we cannot go ourselves. If you have not given to our Home Missions Offering, I encourage you to do so. There are mission envelopes in your set of envelopes that are mailed to you at home and there are others in the pew rack, or you can contact the church office and we will make sure your gift is received. We are on mission by giving.

**Be on mission by serving.** This coming Friday and Saturday is our Spring "OperationInAsMuch". We will go into our community and serve in 23 different mission opportunities. I hope you have already signed-up to serve on one of our teams. If not, you can show up on Saturday, April 26th at 8:30 am in the Fellowship Hall, and we will find you a place of service. Words from Andy

A couple of weeks ago, our high school students, during Northbound, were asked to think of questions they were always afraid to ask in church. Many of our students wonder and often hesitant to ask difficult questions because they are not sure how adults would respond. They do not want to be judged, so they keep the questions to themselves. What we desire for our students is that our homes and our church are safe places where they can ask questions.

Andrew Zirschky at the Center for Youth Ministry Training says, "If we are going to respond adequately to the doubting experiences of youth, we need to ensure that young people ... have patient, understanding companions who can guide and care for them through the twists and turns of the journey of doubt." Our parents and adult leaders at church are the companions Zirschky describes.

As parents and adult leaders, we often do not have answers to the difficult questions our teenagers sometimes ask. Brad Griffin of Fuller Youth Institute suggests we have four



Spring has sprung and we are off to warmer weather! We have just celebrated Easter and summer plans are in the near future. As you make plans to be with loved ones for a family reunion, go on a family vacation, or just take a day to be with each other, be sure you take Christ with you. By this I mean, Christ should be an important part of our lives each day, even while on vacation.

It is important that our children see us as disciples of Christ every day, not just at church or around certain people. Live a disciplined life that is honoring to Christ in everything you do and that example will be portrayed to your children as well. This will be the legacy you pass on to the next generation.

## Family Connections

Cooking in the kitchen provides a time where kids see their parents in a servant role at home. Let them be a part of serving by preparing a meal together for now, to freeze for later, or for a neighbor.

## **Easy Enchiladas**

1 lb. ground beef

½ c. chopped onion

½ c. chopped green pepper

1 can enchilada sauce.

8 oz. milk

1 can cream of chicken soup 2 c. grated Cheddar cheese

corn or flour tortillas

1 can refried beans

Sauté ground beef, onions, and green peppers. Drain fat and set aside.

In a separate mixing bowl, combine enchilada sauce, milk, soup, and 1 cup grated cheese. Soften tortilla shells (if using corn) in microwave for easy rolling. Spread each tortilla with approximately 1 tablespoon of refried beans; then spoon on some of the beef mixture.

Spoon on some of the cheese-soup mixture and roll up the enchilada. Place it in an aluminum foil pan. Repeat until you've used all the tortillas. Pour any extra sauce over the enchiladas. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Prepare a baking instruction label, if freezing, and stick it to the pan lid. Bake 30 minutes at 350 degrees.

\*\*\*Let the children help spoon on the cold mixture and roll the enchiladas.
