The preacher of Ecclesiastes reminds us that there is a season for everything under heaven. Each year, during the first two weeks of May, I am reminded of this truth. This past Sunday we celebrated our Sr. Adult and Baptist Heritage Day. It was a day of reflection on the past and how it has shaped us. This coming Sunday we will celebrate Mother's Day and as we do each Mother's Day, we will join with parents in dedicating themselves and their children to God. We will vow to take the passing of faith seriously with those whom God has placed in our faith family. I give thanks to God that I am a part of a church where both of these moments occur in worship.

This coming Sunday I will do what many of you have done before and that is to celebrate Mother's Day after the death of your mother. These days, like many on our calendar, cause us to reflect. These days can be filled with grief when memories and the realization of loss come flooding back into our consciousness. Those moments of grief can interrupt the most normal of everyday moments and return us to a time when loss was deep. I know that this Sunday may be the same for some of you, even if your mother has passed many years ago. This Sunday, others among us will be celebrating their first Mother's Day as they proudly bring their child for dedication. Still, others will sit quietly in the grief of a dream unfulfilled in their life as they either chose or could not have children. Mother's Day, as I have learned as a pastor, is an emotional day for so many in the congregation and these emotions are varied and deep.

Whatever might be your experience, the church is the place to bring those emotions. If it is joy, then it is right to be in worship and celebrate giving thanks to God for new life. If it is grief, then bring that grief to God and find healing in the presence of God and with God's people. If it is thanksgiving for the gift of a loving mother, whether they are still alive or have gone on to be with the Lord, worship is the place to lift your heart and voice in thanksgiving.

## Concepts a Child Needs to Have to Make a Profession of Faith

Have you ever thought about what one needs to know or feel secure about when making a decision to follow Christ the rest of their life? Eugene Chamberlain wrote a small book many decades ago titled: *When Can a Child Believe?* It laid a huge foundation for us in the children's faith business. Here are some of his thoughts.

The Bible offers only one plan of salvation. Many Bible students identify four major elements in this plan: Repent, Believe, Accept, and Confess. Check out these concepts a child needs to understand and be aware of when discovering faith and following Jesus the rest of his/her life.

- God is my Creator.
- God expects certain behavior from me.
- I do some things that are not pleasing to God, but my overall behavior does not meet God's expectations.
- I am so sorry that I do not meet God's expectations that I wish never again to displease Him.
- I want God to forgive me for not meeting His expectations.

- God sent His Son, Jesus, to be my guide and model.
- Jesus Christ died because God wanted me—and other people to be saved from the consequences of living my way rather than living His way.
- If I trust Jesus to be my Savior, God will forgive me for my wrongdoing and wrong attitudes.
- If I ask Jesus to be my Savior, I must also promise to do my best to live always as He shows me how to live.

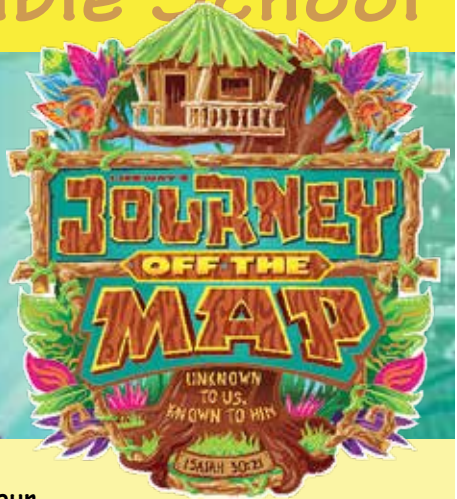
