In some way, the first two Sundays of May epitomize our devotion to being an intergenerational congregation. The first Sunday is led by our Sr. Adults as we celebrate faithfulness and give thanks to God for his faithfulness and our church's past. On the second Sunday of May, we take time to dedicate the youngest of our congregation as parents stand before their church and vow to raise their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord. It is on this day we think of the future and by faith believe the same God who was faithful in the past has a future for us together.

As an intergenerational congregation, we are devoted to creating moments where we learn from one another and we share in the burdens and hopes of every generation. Kenyan Baptists hope to establish a church in each of the villages they build a home. Through our team's work, we will build 16 homes in 16 different villages with the hope of establishing 16 churches in Kenya. 

Message for Mommy

Being a Mom is a tough job. It does have rewarding moments, but it also entails moments that can cause mothers to feel anxiety at its highest. When these moments arise, remember what Paul teaches us in Philippians 4: 6-7. Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guide your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. That means no concern is too big for God to handle or too small for Him to care about. He cares about everything in your life! Everything from a baby's cry to the power bill, from relationships to bad habits we need

to eliminate. He is the author of peace! When you have reason for anxiety but choose to grin a lot, others will see the peace that comes from Him by your calmness. When Christ dwells in you, you can live without anxiety! Present EVERYTHING to God in prayer! He can handle it!

Teachable Moments

Teachable moments with your children will present themselves today. Don't let them pass unnoticed. Be alert to answer your children's needs. Sometimes you may be too tired or busy to notice a yearning child at your feet. Pause for moments to listen to your children everyday. Pray that God's wisdom will flow from you, even in the casual moments. Thank God for persons who provide positive influences in your children's lives.
