This past Sunday our congregation chose to approve the Trustee's recommendation to enter into the construction phase of our Capital Building Project. Please read a message from our Trustee Chairperson Chris Stanley.

Trinity Congregation,

During our worship services this morning, we approached a significant decision in the life of our church with thoughtful consideration and prayerful discernment. Each of us expressed our vote based on facts shared and information learned. Yet, the primary help came from our Helper, as we individually and collectively sought direction and guidance from the Holy Spirit. At Trinity, this is how we make significant decisions, always listening to each other, always respecting each other and always coming together in the unity of Christ.

Today, as a congregation, we voted in favor of the motion to proceed with the Capital Building Project with an 87% margin of approval (Yes - 606, No - 94). Based on these affirming results, the Trustees and the Facilities Master Planning Committee will now begin planning for the start of construction.

Regardless of how you voted, thank you for being part of this process, from helping to shape the initial vision that began over eight years ago to participating in the decision that was made today.

I know everyone has a lot of questions concerning what is to happen next. In fact, the transition time is probably causing us the most angst as we face this exciting yet challenging time. Here is what is happening this week in preparation for our transition. This week documents will be signed with our bank and our builder. Permit processes will continue with the city. Our transition team has ordered chairs for the ROC to be used for worship, once construction has begun. Plans for sound and video for the ROC is being enacted as well as soundproofing the ROC. The Church Council is studying worship times and other logistic and program issues regarding our Fall Programing. Our Sunday School

Council will finalize their recommendations conceding classroom use during the transition to enable our most Senior Adults to be closer to the worship space in the ROC, as well as a plan to enable our Sunday School to grow during our transition time.

As we work through this process in the next month, we will soon know a date for ground breaking, our last day in the sanctuary and our first day of worship in the ROC. There is much to do and much to celebrate.

The next season in the life of Trinity will require all of us to make a sacrifice, be inconvenienced and be faithful. It will be a challenge, but it will mature us as a congregation and as followers of Jesus. I am so grateful for our Trustees and Facilities Planning Committee and the prayerful and careful work they have done. I am grateful to our congregation for the spirit in which we approached this important decision. I am grateful for everyone who has participated in town hall meetings, raised questions and even raised objections. This process has enabled us to arrive at this place. I want to thank all who were here on Sunday and voted their conscience. Regardless if you voted for or against the proposal, I am thankful for your passion and love for our church. Your participation has enabled us to know the will of the congregation. We all love our church and what we all want is for God to continue to use us for God's glory. I am so proud to be the pastor of Trinity Baptist Church and I am excited about the next season of our congregation. To God be the Glory, Great Things He has done!

I have great news - I received word late last night that our congregation voted in favor of the motion and the Trustees have provided their final approval to proceed with the building project. Thank you for all of your dedication and effort over these past 8 years - I am personally grateful for each one of you and your involvement in this project.

Chris will be signing the contract with C&T later this week and Brooks and the transition committee will begin the process of transitioning our congregation through the pre-construction phase of their plan. We anticipate construction to begin in late July. I will update you over the next few weeks and schedule a meeting if necessary as we begin the construction phase.

This week's mission to work with the Roma Gypsies on the western border of Ukraine is going to be amazing – the team is already excited with anticipation of what God is going to do in and through us. The planning of this year's trip has had its challenges– even for NC Baptists on Mission and Hungarian Baptist Aid through which we are serving. Long story made short – getting medications and dental supplies was a huge challenge. We took our own last year, but were told several months ago that this was impossible this year. We would have to find and purchase our supplies there.

A couple of weeks ago, we still did not know how God would work this out. Eszter Kiss with Hungarian Baptist Aid was working hard to locate the medical supplies in Ukraine. Dr. Randy Macon from TBC - the team's only dentist – was working on the dental supplies. He decided to Google Christian dentists in Ukraine. His dental assistant contacted one of the hits, and was told that a retired dentist who had made over 40 dental missions to Ukraine could give Randy the details and contacts to get everything we needed...and he lives in Raleigh, NC! Randy has now made contact with a wonderful Christian mission dentist in Ukraine who is ordering everything we need and bringing it to us.

Words from Katie

This past Sunday Dr Roberts spoke about wisdom. One of the phrases our kids hear frequently at our church is "I can make the wise choice." I love the simplicity of this phrase. It doesn't just speak to our capability, but of the freedom we have to pursue what is best. It doesn't just speak to our freedom, but to the reality that wisdom is not simply accessible to us... it is imbedded within us. Have you ever considered this fact? According to what we learn from God's Word, our kids are created in God's image. Our kids are designed to reflect His character. According to God's Word, when we say yes to Christ. . . when we claim Him as Lord and Savior, God indwells us with the Holy Spirit. *The Holy Spirit is given to*

us to guide, to teach, to help us remember what God has told us (John 14:26). The Holy Spirit is also given so Truth can be revealed through us (John 15:26). This means that our kids are not only designed to be wise, but with the Holy Spirit, they have the very source of Wisdom within them. So the phrase "I can make a wise choice" is not a patronizing statement meant to coerce good behavior. It's a call to press into the very core of who they are in Christ. If words matter, and how I deliver my words matters, then knowing how to phrase an important lesson in simple terms is the parenting tool I need to teach and guide my kids through everyday circumstances. "I can make the wise choice" is one I'll always have in my back pocket.
