

# **VBS Mission Project**

### Disaster Relief Comfort Kits

Response is often needed quickly in the aftermath of a disaster or storm like a hurricane. In keeping with our "Surf—Beach" theme, we are choosing a project that might help victims of a hurricane. Various Baptist Conventions and other Baptist Men's organizations could take comfort kits to children that are victims of a disaster. This year for VBS we are collecting items for a Child's comfort kit or a Baby comfort kit. We are providing gallon size zip-loc bags to use for the kits. We ask that you choose four items from the list below, mark the age on the form we provide and also mark the possible gender then return the sealed kit to VBS or Sunday School.

### Age breakdowns are as follows:

**Baby:** 0-3 months, 3-6 months, 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months, 18-24months

**Child Package:** 2-3 years, 4-5 years, 6-7 years, 8-9 years, 10-12 years

# Needs List: Choose 4 Items to include in your gallon bag.

**Baby:** Diaper, Baby nail clippers, Sippy Cup, Pacifier, Diaper Shirt, Handi-wipes, small soft washable toy or soft book.

**Child:** New Small Stuffed animal, Wash Cloth, doll, books, puzzles, small games, Colors/coloring book, Small toy (age appropriate—cars for boys, etc.), comb/brush

**For all kits:** Bibles and small notes are always welcomed.

We appreciate all who choose to help with this ministry. What a fun way to be pro-active before a disaster happens. Just look for the extra forms around on the grade school and preschool hallway.

## **Blocks Center: More than Play!**

If there is one spot in a preschool classroom that is a perpetual favorite with some children, it is the block area. It is important to know that just because children are absorbed and busy in block play does not mean it is time for their teachers to take a break! Instead we should look for ways to help children enrich their play, and resolve their conflicts or think through situations. Sometimes children will begin to build items of their own choosing, even when you have stated that we are going to build a certain thing. That's okay! What is important is that you stay involved with the block building. Look for ways you can connect the child's

activity with the Bible story or verse. Block building provides firsthand experiences in practicing concepts such as sharing, helping, take turns, and exercising self control. So next time the kids are in the block area see it as a learning opportunity to learn, teach, and grow together.
