This coming Sunday is Graduate Day at Trinity. It is always a special day of recognition, reflection and celebration. Many of those who will walk across the stage this coming week were once dedicated in this church or another church when they were infants or children. Many of our graduates also entered the waters of baptism in our sanctuary. This day is a reminder that the church is not simply a place to for religious consumption but instead the church is a people, family, and community on "the way" together. We rejoice with our graduates at this moment of accomplishment and transition. We pray for them as they seek new opportunities and follow God's will for their lives. As a parent who has been a part of several graduations over the past 6 years I know that this is also a time of reflection. In these moments we reassess our own lives and role as parent. Sometimes we can feel guilty and inadequate. Other times we can feel a sense of satisfaction. I pray that all of our parents will find peace and grace for the things they wished they had done and did not do as a parent. I also pray that in that peace of God's continued presence in the life of their graduate they will know the joy that comes from sharing in their child's accomplishment.

This past Sunday at the Sanderson High Baccalaureate Service, Rev. Justin King gave a great word to the graduates. Using the Temptation of Jesus as his text, he reminded the graduates that not always is the way of following Jesus and being obedient the easy way. In fact, to discover and pursue God's purpose for their lives might be the hardest thing they have ever done, yet it would be worth every moment of challenge.

If you want trip insurance, that must be paid at time of deposit. The cost is roughly \$100 for \$1000 coverage (a \$3,500 trip will be around \$350).
