Joining Hands with God

The month of June is traditionally the time for the larger Baptist family to come together for assembly and conventions. This past week, the Southern Baptist Convention held its annual meeting in St. Louis, MO on June 14 and 15. Many are calling this an historic gathering due to several resolutions, which were passed during the meeting. The messengers to the SBC affirmed several resolutions. These included:

- 1. A resolution of compassion and prayer for the victims in the Orlando shooting incident. Calling all people "Image bearers of God and our neighbors."
- 2. A call for the refraining of displaying the Confederate Flag. The resolution calls for Christians to discontinue the display of the Confederate Flag for the sake of unity within the body of Christ. The resolution reads, "We urge fellow Christians to exercise sensitivity, so that nothing brings division or hinders the unity of the Body of Christ to be a bold witness to the transforming power of Jesus."
- 3. A call for churches to welcome refugees. The resolution reads "We encourage Southern Baptist churches and families to welcome and adopt refugees into their churches and homes as a means to demonstrate to the nations that our God longs for every tribe, tongue, and nation to be welcomed at His throne. We call on the governing

authorities to implement the strictest security measures possible in the refugee screening and selection process, guarding against anyone intent on doing harm; and we affirm that refugees are people loved by God, made in His image, and that Christian love should be extended to them as special objects of God's mercy in a world that has displaced them from their homelands."

4. A resolution reiterating the Biblical view of marriage as between one man and one woman and calling for dissent in regards to same sex marriage. This resolution also states "We express our love for our neighbors who identify as transgender, seek their good always, welcome them to our churches and, as they repent and believe in Christ, receive them into church membership."

If you would like to read all portions of these resolutions and the others from the convention go to SBC.NET and search resolutions 2016. In addition, it is important to note that resolutions, which occur at the Southern Baptist Convention, are not binding nor have authority over congregations or individual Baptists. They are the statements of those who have gathered in that moment as messengers to the Southern Baptist Convention.

This coming week our mission partner, The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, will be meeting in Greensboro on June 22-24. This will be the 25th year celebration for the CBF. The CBF, unlike the SBC, is not a denomination but a fellowship of churches and individuals who partner together in ministry. The emphasis for the gathering this year is to celebrate what God has done in the past 25 years and to look forward to the future. One highlight will be the commissioning of the largest number of church starters in the organization's history. In addition, a renewed commitment to funding of long-term resident missionaries will be an emphasis. The CBF's seeks to focus on missions, theological education and starting and renewing congregations. You are welcome to attend the assembly in Greensboro. If you want more information about this year's assembly go to CBF.NET.

DISASTER RELIEF: MONTHLY MISSIONS Rebuild Flooded Homes in Johnsonville, SC

This past week, the Disaster Relief Lead Team at TBC met to discuss plans for the months ahead. The team has done a lot of good work locally, building wheel chair ramps for church and community members as well as doing major repairs to two homes – one in North Hills area and one in southern Wake County.

Following the terrible flooding in SC several months ago, we prepared for action and awaited the orders from NC Baptist Disaster Relief to go. We were not needed at that time. But now SC Baptists are requesting our help – to rebuild the homes that were flooded where other teams have already removed the damaged flooring, sheet rock and insulation.
