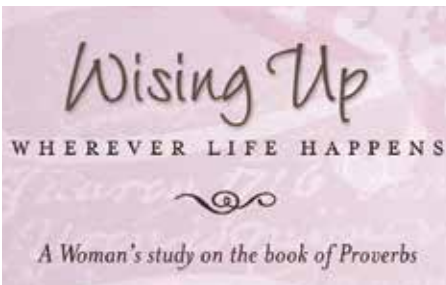
North Raleigh Ministries Food Drive & Love Offering

Yes, they can follow instructions from someone else, eat their lunch, be responsible for their belongings, and gain confidence in knowing that they are able to do so. You may even be surprised to see how confident and responsible they are. If you haven't already, begin to establish a routine in the evening and the morning. Kids love consistency and having a routine to follow. Do as much the night before, like packing lunches, preparing book bags for the next day, and laying out clothes. This helps your mornings run smoother and may allow for an extra moment together. This is a great time to have a morning prayer together! As they see you trusting God to look after their needs in your absence, they learn to trust Him too.

Set aside some time to talk about their day or week and listen to them express themselves. They are processing a new experience and they need to be assured that you are there for them, supporting them, praying for them, and loving them. Encourage them and express how proud you are of them. Celebrate with a special movie night or ice cream treat. Make cookies or brownies and let them help. This is a growing milestone; so celebrate thanking God for the start of a wonderful school year.
