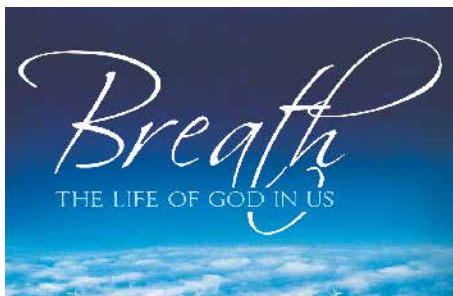
Dr. Roberts' Sabbatical

ALL of the proceeds are used to lease the building, cover NRM's utility bills, pay several staff members, and build the Benevolence Fund out of which the Crisis Center is able to help neighbors in need.
