Joining Hands with God

I am excited to let you know that the date has been set for our groundbreaking ceremony for our new building. We will hold a groundbreaking on August 28, 2016. This will also be the last day we plan to be in the Sanctuary. We are on a timetable that would make September 4, 2016 our first day for worship in the ROC. All is being prepared for this day. Sunday School classes are moving to new spaces, a new sound system is being installed in the ROC, the Pac Man storage units are in place and our chairs for the ROC are to arrive the second week of August.

As we near this time of transition to the ROC and our campus in construction, I want to encourage you to make a commitment; a commitment to being a part of making this time of "disruption" a time of growth for not only us as a church, but also for you as an individual. There are many things that you can do to make a difference in the life of our church during this time. How can you make a difference?

- If you are a regular worshipper at the 10:55 a.m. service, you might want to commit to worship at 8:45 a.m. during the transition. We estimate we need 100 people to make this commitment. The ROC will hold 750 people for worship. To make sure we create space for everyone, we need to have 300 or more in the 8:45 a.m. worship service each week. A simple adjustment of your schedule can make a great difference for our church.
- You can park remotely. We have 80 spots across Six Forks Rd. for our use each Sunday. On an average, only 12 to 15 spaces are used each week. If you would make it a habit to park there on Sunday you can make a great difference. We will have an officer to direct traffic and allow crossing of Six Forks Rd. at the light in front of Capital Towers. If your family drives two cars to church due to schedules, consider having one of them parked across the street.
- Keep your pledge to the Capital Campaign. If you have not been giving toward your
 pledge, now is the time to begin. Our cash flow through our giving will help us in the
 construction process as we near completion and finalize our loan amount. The more we
 have, the less we have to borrow. If you have not made a pledge you can do so. You
 might even discover you can give more than you thought when we began the campaign.
 Be in prayer about your financial commitment.
- Attend more and not less. This is the time in the life of the church to be more faithful and not less. Our attendance will encourage each other during the transition, and it will build

The apartment was near Cameron Village. Now they are moving to 7011 Sandy Forks Road into the Cedar Point Apartments. Marc and Kim Wyatt, missionaries hosting the house are calling out to all churches for help in moving. "We are excited about this new location. It provides a wonderful community social network for our guests, has after school ESL programs, an easy bus line, and will provide multi-use space for our ministry".
