With the dawn of each new season of the year, we anticipate the changes each one brings. The warmth of the sunny summer months turns to the crisp, color-laden days of fall; fall turns to the months where the outside beauty of nature deadens to the lively celebrations and warmth of the home at Thanksgiving and Christmas. Winter's chill and the icy snow days are short-lived, eventually turning into the beautiful array of flowers, butterflies, and spring weather. Before long, summer is back upon us, and we start all over again.

As I'm getting older, those days seem to pass more quickly! And so do the days of ministry.

Here we are at the dawn of a new school and church year. Just when we begin teaching classes of preschoolers and children, they are soon graduating and moving on to another stage of life. Each of these generations is precious to God and to us at Trinity. Another year is dawning; dear Father, let it be, In working or in waiting, another year with Thee; Another year of progress, another year of praise, Another year of proving Thy presence all the days.

Another year of service, of witness for Thy love; Another year of training for holier work above, Another year is dawning; dear Father, let it be, On earth or else in heaven, another year for Thee.


