Deepen The Ties That Bind

Names are important. Most of us cherish our names and we are proud of what they mean and those who share it. As followers of Jesus we are proud to be called by the Name, Christian. Names are not only important to people, but what we name or call places and spaces are important. The house, condo or apartment we call home has a special meaning to us. At Trinity 10 years ago we chose to call the gym “The Recreation Outreach Center”, instead of “Family Life Center.” That subtle name change, expressed the mission of this new facility and its purpose according to our church’s mission.

In our August Deacon’s Meeting, our Chairperson Sam Spilman made a comment as we closed the meeting. In his closing, what he stated reminded me of an important truth. Sam commented to the Deacons that when we meet next in September, we would be in our “new sanctuary.” Sam was referring to our move to the ROC during our time of construction, which will occur on September 4, 2016. What I found profound about Sam’s statement was his use of the term “sanctuary”.

At Trinity, we have long used a term that many churches have turned from as the description of the place and space where the church gathers for worship. Many congregations use the term “Worship Center”, instead of “sanctuary”. Honestly, that is what our sign will say guiding people to the ROC for worship during the construction period. However, I think Sam is on to something by using the term “sanctuary”.

The term “sanctuary” means a holy and sacred place set aside for worship. What makes a place holy and sacred? Is it the way it looks? Is it the number of stain glass windows? What exactly makes a place holy and sacred? Of course the answer is that a “sanctuary” is not about its looks as much as it is about who gathers there. In a few weeks our “sanctuary” is making a journey across our campus. Our “sanctuary” is going with us. We are leaving our room on our campus and going to another but make no misstate about it, we are not leaving our “sanctuary” we are taking it with us.

Have You Paid Your Child Support?

One of the blights on the last several generations have been the proliferation of parents, especially fathers, who fail to honor the obligations which they have to their children. Often a judge will incarcerate a person for failing to make "child support" payments.

Today's churches have children who are being denied proper encouragement and opportunities for adequate nourishment. The lack of "child support" I am talking about is that every Sunday of the year Bible study departments for preschoolers and children are scandalously short of Bible teachers. Many Sunday School departments operate weekly with as little as 25-50 percent of the leadership required to meet the spiritual needs of these

children. Those people who do give of their time and heart to staff these departments may not be able to teach in the manner that best enables children to learn about Jesus and, when the time is right, give their hearts and lives to Him. For many of these workers keeping order or just attending to physical needs of the children takes up most of their time.

Thirty years ago in most churches a group of dedicated workers often gave their entire teaching ministries to the boys and girls. Today, there is more of a tendency toward sending a different person each week or month, or a person only committing to a month of service at a time.

There are many possible solutions but here are a few:

- Parents of the children must step forward and provide the "PeoplePower" to make sure the best teaching is available to their children
- The entire membership must join forces with the parents to bolster these ranks with the best we have.
- Church leaders must keep before the membership the growing need for members to prepare themselves for this task.
- The adult SS teachers need to spiritually prepare their class members to be able to grow and serve.

As long as members feel their own teachers do not want them to leave the "nest of learning," they will never meet the challenge. The prolonged effect of this neglect will bring as much shame to our ranks as the one who is placed in a cell because they did not legally provide the best resources.

Dare we Christians not take the same question as seriously as we consider, "Have you paid your child support?"
