Joining Hands with God

At the center of the altar, in most Baptist churches, you will find the Lord's Supper Table. On the center of the table will be an open Bible. This is more than decoration but is a declaration. The open Bible, as the center focus, is a declaration that as Baptist we believe the Bible to be God's written word. The Bible is open because it is to be preached, taught, studied and lived. We believe in open inquiry of the Bible not only by trained clergy, but also by everyone. We believe the same Holy Spirit that inspired the writing of the Bible lives in each and every believer. Thus, when we read the Bible the Spirit that inspired the writing gives to believer's understanding. As Baptists, we have been known as "people of the book." We have resisted the use of creeds, but insisted that the Bible is our only creed. As Dr. Lydia Hoyle reminded us in our class on Baptist History, "Early Baptist history is messy because when it came to the Bible the Baptists wanted to get it right."

It is true that because we want to "get it right", we are constantly going back to the open Bible and reading the texts again and again. We study and prayerfully ask questions. We study the Bible not only as individuals, but also in community with the hope that we might gain further insight into understanding. Our goal is not only to receive understanding and information, but also to be able to apply our understanding. We want to "know the Bible" and be obedient to God's commands so we might demonstrate our love for God. In this way, we not only open the Bible but we also open our minds, hearts and actions to the Bible.

This coming Sunday, we will be focusing our attention on our core value of discipleship. The guide for our discipleship must be the open Bible. The Bible remains our most important text for study and for following Jesus. Because of the importance of the Bible it has been misused and misunderstood by some and




