Deepen The Ties That Bind

In January, our Personnel Committee began a discussion with several staff members concerning new roles on our staff. In June, we announced that Rev. Spencer Good would officially be assuming a role, along with Recreation, to oversee the administrative tasks on the ministerial staff. Rev. Good supervises our non-ministerial staff, with the exception of the Week Day Preschool and our Accompanists. He also works with several committees who oversee our campus, facilities, office and maintenance.

In addition to Rev. Good, the Personnel Committee has been in conversation with Rev. Lydia Tatum and Christian Davis. In accessing the needs of the congregation and our mission together, the Personnel Committee began a process to explore the roles for these two ministers. It has been our practice to discover how each member of the ministerial staff can continue to grow and bring added leadership to our congregation. This coming Sunday evening, during our August Church Conference, the Personnel Committee will recommend new roles for Lydia and Christian. Lydia would become our Associate Pastor for Ministry and Outreach. She will assume leadership in leading our congregation in the areas of evangelism and community involvement with our changing and emerging North Hills Community. She will assist the Senior Pastor in all areas of Pastoral Ministry including: teaching, preaching, curriculum writing, pastoral care, counseling and visitation. Christian would become our Minister to Students and take the lead in

our important ministry to Middle Schoolers, High Schoolers and College Students.

This process began with conversations with Lydia and Christian about their roles and gifts. The next step was to expand this conversation to the Student Ministry Committee. After feedback from the Student Ministry Committee and upon their recommendations, the Personnel Committee proceeded to develop new job descriptions and continue the conversation with Lydia and Christian. In July, our Personnel Committee Chairperson, Mike O'Mara, shared with the deacons our conversations and plans to move forward with recommending to the congregation new roles for these two ministers. This past week, the Personnel Committee shared with parents and students attending our Student luncheon, the plan to make this recommendation. The final step will be to make this as a formal recommendation in our August Church Conference on August 21, 2016.

I am sure there are some questions regarding this change, so let me share some information that might answer some of those questions:

- The plan has the full acceptance of Lydia and Christian. Both of the ministers involved have been fully engaged in the process and are excited about the future.
- The Personnel Committee has been deliberate in this process receiving input from appropriate committees and church

leadership. (All conversations have been positive and the Personnel Committee has been encouraged to move forward.

- The Personnel Budget will support the changes which are proposed. The Personnel Committee has been planning for a proposal of a new position and has budgeted accordingly.
- It is the intent of the Personnel Committee, working with the Student Ministry Committee, to begin the process of filling the part-time Student Ministry Associate position as soon as a proper search can be done.
- If the vote is positive during Church Conference, the start date will be September 1.

Finally, on a personal note let me say how excited I am about this proposed change. One of the joys of being the pastor of this church is to watch people develop and find their place in ministry. I have had the privilege of working with Lydia and Christian and it has become obvious to those who work alongside them that they both are gifted ministers. Each have the particular gifts to excel in these new roles. I have full confidence in both of them and what they have to offer our congregation. In addition, because of the way our staff works as a team, this transition should be seamless. Lydia will be able to maintain ministry and relationships in the congregation and also be a resource to Christian through the process. I am looking forward to our work together as a ministerial staff, and more importantly to our ministry as a congregation.

A reminder that our August Church Conference follows our Pot-Luck Fellowship Supper on Sunday night, August 21, 2016. Supper begins at 6:00 p.m. and the conference will follow.
