Joining Hands with God

One of our core values is fellowship. When we hear this word we might think of gathering to eat and share some moments with others. The early church valued fellowship as they valued worship and prayer. They gathered to encourage each other and share life together. In a large congregation like Trinity, fellowship becomes difficult but also more important. In our core value statement we say we value fellowship that is intentional. Intentional fellowship means it takes effort. Intentional fellowship means we must make it a priority in our lives and make time for it in our week. One of the ways we find fellowship in our congregation is in the Sunday School class. These “smaller” groups are where we meet others and learn to share life with others in the church. As important as these relationships are in our congregation, we also need to move beyond this circle and share our lives with the greater congregation. The comment I hear from members of every age in our congregation is “I don’t believe I know them.” As our church has grown in the past decade and we have conducted two worship services the one core value that has suffered, in my opinion, is fellowship.

One of my concerns as your Pastor, over the past several years, is the loss of a connection of members to the whole congregation. We have built strong Sunday School classes and that is essential. It is true you grow larger as a congregation by creating more small groups. We continue to create new Sunday School classes as a way of helping people connect. We have offered various worship times, which is necessary not only because of space but also with lifestyles of people within the congregation. All of this has enabled us to grow in numbers. However what I have observed is an unintended consequence has been the loss of connection of many members to the larger “fellowship.” One of the reasons that fellowship is one of our core values is because we, as a congregation, have said that we did not want to become a church where we did not know each other or where we felt we were among strangers.

What are we to do? We have to return to our stated value. We must make fellowship an intentional act. We have several weekly opportunities for all of us to build relationships beyond our Sunday School class. Our Wednesday night “Fellowship Supper” is designed for us to gather and get to know one another. We should not underestimate the simple act of gathering to share a meal. It was at the heart of the life of the early church and remains one of the best ways to create friendship. We also offer on Wednesday nights other “small groups” through our discipleship, music and missions ministries. These classes and programs create new moments where we meet new people and make relationships across
