Words from Lydia

Recently in my devotional readings, I have chosen to pick up an old favorite, *The Epistle to the Romans* by Karl Barth. Barth is one of the most influential theologians of the twentieth century, shaping Protestant thought and theology in a rapidly changing world. He was the leader of the German Confessing Church, which during the reign of the Third Reich formed as an ecclesial body in direct opposition to the Third Reich and its ideology and domination of German Christians for its racist agenda.

Barth came into my life in my early college days, and as I read his cornerstone work, *The Epistle to the Romans*, my love for God, my thirst for knowledge, and my hunger for theology grew insatiably. So, as I come back to this theological work, my expectations are, of course, quite high. Here is a bit of what I have been reading: "Grace is the

incomprehensible fact that God is well pleased with a man, and that a man can rejoice in God."

When we find ourselves unable to ignore the cycle of our sin—if it is not one thing it's another—how can we find ourselves justified in approaching a God who is Holy? We cannot without the divine miracle. We cannot without Jesus Christ. It is only by this grace that we can know and be truly known by the God who is Love.

You may be seeing more Barth quotes in the coming months as food for thought, but as for now, let us rejoice in the God who preforms miracles—the God of Grace.
