Deepen The Ties That Bind

As I write my article this week, I am reminded of the years of prayer, work and deliberation that has brought us to this coming Sunday. It has been nearly a decade since a conversation in a Trustee meeting began the process that would become the Facilities Master Planning Committee. This committee has worked diligently over the years to help us arrive at this time of construction. Along the way, so many others joined in through our Capital Campaign, Financial Assessment Team, Transition Team and Construction Team. Others, who were serving on various committees in the church, also became involved in this incredible process. In addition, our church continued to discuss, deliberate, pray and vote to move forward in this important undertaking.

As you Pastor, I know the anxiety that many of you might be feeling during this time of transition. Any time we are asked to change our routine or move from familiar surroundings there is hesitancy. I am confident that our Transition Team and Church Staff have done all they can to make this move as easy as possible. We have tried to make sure that our schedule stays the same each Sunday, as well as making sure we have room for everyone when it comes to worship and Sunday School. I am sure we will discover other needs and challenges along the way, and we will work hard at addressing these as they are discovered.

This past Sunday, as I was preaching on Abraham being called to go to a place he did not know, God was speaking to me. Yes, as odd as it might sound, sometimes my sermons speak to me. I've been reflecting on the term I used, "unsettled." In Genesis, Abraham along with his father traveled to Haran and "settled" there. Later, God would call Abraham to pack up everything he had and set out on a journey to a land he would show him. In Hebrews 11. the writers remind us that Abraham lived in tents. In other words, Abraham became "unsettled." What excites me is the Bible attests that God does wonderful things in times when people are unsettled. Whether it is Abraham, Joseph, or Moses in the Exodus, the time of Exile or even the scattering of the Church from persecution in the book of Acts; an unsettling creates an incredible opportunity to experience God in new ways.

My friends, this is my prayer as we enter this important week. As we gather in the Sanctuary for worship and we recall all of those wonderful moments of worship in that room, we will also with great courage and excitement... exit on Sunday, making our own journey across the campus to the R.O.C. with the expectation of God doing something new in our lives throughout the next 16 months

The time has come for us to be obedient to God's call to us as a congregation. What we are getting ready to embark upon will set the course for our church for generations to come. Just as those 60 years ago met and covenanted together formed Trinity Baptist Church, we too must covenant together to pray, serve, give and be faithful to each other... and to our congregation in these
