Words from Carla

The next few weeks, I would like to share ways on how we can help a preschooler pray. Young children who are taught to communicate with the father in a personal way, rather than through a memorized prayer, realize additional strength and support from One who is always with them. Teaching a preschooler to pray is one of the greatest securities that can be given to a child, a far greater inheritance than anything else.

How can you help a preschooler get ready to talk to God?

- Discuss things which you want to thank God.
- Express the need of prayer. "We can ask God to help us to..." or "Let's ask God to..."
- Sing a song about Jesus or God's love ~ even a simple song about prayer.
- Talk about why we usually close our eyes as we pray. (We can pray with our eyes

open, but we usually close them to blot out other things. We want to concentrate on God and what He can do.)

- Help the child realize that talking with God is a significant time.
- Talk about how God loves and cares for each one of us.
