Words from Katie

As we begin a new church year, I've been reviewing the ways that preschoolers learn so we can teach our children to the best of our abilities. I wanted to share some ways that they learn. As you look over the ways that preschoolers learn from an article by Tommy Sanders, I encourage you to think of ways you can incorporate his learning styles within your preschool ministry. We have been given and trusted with the great (and rewarding) task of teaching our youngest members. May we do it with joy, grace, and to the best of our abilities!

Senses: Preschoolers learn to discover the things God has made through touching, smelling, tasting, hearing, and seeing.

Curiosity: Exploring the world is a lifelong process. Curiosity in the adult world is evidenced by space programs, science, technology, archaeology, and through many careers and fields of study. A preschooler's curiosity drives him to explore, discover, and ask "why?"

Hands On Experience: "Hands-on" means teaching the child in an activity that leads her to a greater understanding of a Bible truth. In hands on teaching, preschoolers are guided through an activity toward a Bible truth that can be understood and applied in that moment and in the child's life.

Satisfaction: When a child is involved in satisfying experiences, the child gains a sense of accomplishment. As a result, the child can realize that he is unique and created in the image of God.

Relationships: Relationships form eternal connections between the child and biblical truth. For preschoolers, who do not have the benefit of adult language, the relationship with a teacher becomes a living commentary on the Scripture.

Please let Katie know by September 7th if you will need childcare for the September 11th viewing of War Room. **Imitation:** How does a child learn to respect and love others? She begins to learn by the way she is loved and respected. Preschoolers follow the lead of adults in their lives. Actions as well as words of adults teach the child.

Play: Playing and learning are inseparable for preschoolers. Play offers the greatest opportunity for Bible teaching. Through play, a child can learn and apply important truths, relate in positive ways to others, accept responsibility, and solve problems. But play is just activity unless the teacher guides the activity and discussion toward foundational biblical truths.

Repetition: "Not this Bible story again." This statement is uttered by some adults who teach preschoolers. These adults don't understand that preschoolers need the repetition of Bible truths and Bible stories. Repetition allows the child to build on previous foundational truths and understand more fully the truth he has already heard.

Join us in our mission project:

We want our youngest members to learn about missions here at Trinity. This fall we are partnering with the Wake County Pajama Program. Pajama Program provides new pajamas and new books to children in need nationwide, many of whom are waiting to be adopted. These children live in group homes, shelters and temporary housing facilities and are shuffled often from one place to another. We are inviting and asking you to participate with us this fall as Mission Friends. Please bring in a new set of pajamas in your child's size as well as a new book that a child might enjoy reading during bed time. I encourage you to take your child with you to help select the book and pajamas. This will be an opportunity for you to have a conversation with your child about missions and why it is important to help others. Collection will be September 7th through October 28th.
