At the conclusion of my sermon this past Sunday, I told the story of Tom Smith and the Clay Pot congregation. Tom asked his congregation to engage in several activities for which they would keep each other accountable. I would like to share them with you as suggestion for our life together at Trinity. Tom asked his church to:

- Plug into God's Word everyday (Let's commit to read the Bible daily).
- Break bread with others and with someone who is not in the church.
- Ask not "what is my spiritual gift?" but "how am I a gift to this community of faith?".
- Develop friendships with those different than me.
- Have a servant mentality in regards to time, talent and money.
- Have a healthy rhythm to life in regards to work, play and worship.
- Find someone with whom to be accountable.

In regards to this idea, I asked us as the church at Trinity Baptist to consider these commitments around our Core Values:

**Worship** - Let us encourage each other to attend worship and not stop meeting together as some are in the habit of doing.

**Fellowship** - Let us encourage each other to have meals with those in the church who we have never had a meal with before.

**Missions** - Let us encourage each other to build relationships with those who do not know Christ.

**Discipleship** -Let us encourage each other to spend time daily reading the Bible and spending moments in prayer.

**Ministry** - Let us encourage each other to live lives of compassion whereby we laugh when others rejoice and cry when others cry. Let us determine that we will not let those in our fellowship live life in loneliness.

*Let us consider how we can spur one another toward love and good deeds... encouraging each other all the more as we see the day approaching.* – Hebrews 10:24-25

## Praying - How Do You Set The Right Example?

One of the best ways to teach preschoolers to pray is to set the example! Parents who pray spontaneously with a child impress that child with the fact that God is always near. Use every opportune moment to let the child hear you communicate with the Father such as:



- When observing a beautiful flower
- When looking at a book together and being reminded of God's love and care
- When viewing a colorful sunset on your way home in the car
- With children under two, a parent will pray naturally in conversational tones, stating simply: "Thank You God for Elizabeth's beautiful eyes" or "Thank You, God, for birds."

### Guidelines to remember:

- Begin with a simple salutation such as "Dear God."
- Keep the vocabulary simple
- Use short, uninvolved sentences
- Pray briefly. Remember the short attention span of preschoolers.
- Close with Amen

Family prayers generate appreciations for one another and for the contribution each make to the family.

Family prayer time can make for healthy, wholesome living as the members come together to recognize God's presence in their midst.

*"Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up".*
