Now, 15 years later, we are still aware that this threat to innocent lives across our world and in our own nation remains. As we consider that tragic day and how our world has changed, I want to encourage us as followers of Jesus to pray for our leaders and our world.

Let us pray for the families of the victims of 9/11 who must live with the deep grief of lives cut short by terror. Let us remember the individuals who must live life with injuries, both physical and psychological as a result of the attack.

Let us not forget the first responders, not only who responded on that day, but those who have responded on all the days since. Let us remember firefighters, policemen and EMT workers who respond everyday to people in crisis.

May we continue to pray for all who work diligently to protect us as citizens of this great Nation. Let us not forget the families of those who have lost loved ones in the wars and conflicts that have occurred as a result of 9/11, and our military men and women who serve our nation. Let us pray, as we are charged by scripture, for those who are our political leaders.

As followers of Jesus, let us also pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ and all who live in war torn places. Let us not forget that many in our world know daily the terrible reality of terror and its destruction. As followers of Jesus, let us also practice the hardest of instructions from Jesus, which is to love our enemies and pray for those who would do us harm. Let us practice the example of Jesus who forgave the very ones who unjustly crucified him. Let us trust that God will judge and that God is just.

Finally, let us pray for one another. Let us pray that we will not be a people ruled by fear, but inspired by our faith in our Lord Jesus. Let us believe that the gospel story of Jesus is still the world's greatest story and it alone can transform lives, nations and the world.

For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only Son, that whosoever would believe in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. I believe this is true, even in a world changed by 9/11.

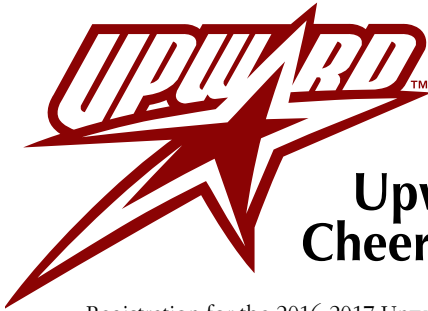
