Following Jesus...

As Baptist we observe two ordinances in our church. The first is baptism. We practice believer's baptism by immersion. Every one of those words is important in our practice of baptism. We believe the New Testament witness concerning baptism is an act of obedience in response to one's confession that Jesus is Lord. Once a person confesses Jesus is Lord, the first act of obedience to this confession is to be baptized as an outward expression of one's faith. We also practice immersion because we believe this to be the meaning of the word for baptism as found in the New Testament. Immersion is not only the Biblical mode of baptism, but also a beautiful mode of baptism. This mode of baptism identifies us with Christ, his death, burial and resurrection and also expresses our new faith that we have died to an old way of life and have been raised in a newness of life. We rejoice with those who come this Sunday to express their faith in Christ.

We also will be observing the Lord's Supper. We are instructed from the Apostle Paul that as often as we eat the bread and drink of the cup, we are to do so in remembrance of the Lord's death, until he comes again. The Lord's Supper for the Baptist is a time of remembrance and relationship. It is a time of remembering what God did for us through the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. It is Jesus and only through Jesus that we come into a right relationship with God and have the hope of resurrection and eternal life. We remember at the table that we are sinful and in need of forgiveness. Jesus' death provided that forgiveness is for us. So, at the Lord's Supper we remember Jesus' death and we look forward to as well. We remember the Lord's death, until the Lord Jesus comes. We are a remembering people, but also a hopeful people. Jesus has gone to prepare a place for us and will one day take us to be where He is that we might dwell with Jesus forever. The Lord's Table is a place of hope, as well as remembrance.

It is also a place for relationships. We are reminded of our relationship with God through Jesus, but also with one another. In Baptist practice, we pass the elements of the bread and cup down the pews to one another. We do not come to the ministers, but as we give and receive the elements we practice what it means to all be priests and to be priests to each other. I am looking forward to us being at the Lord's Table together.

On the day we come to the Lord's Table at Trinity we practice being in relationships. We read our Church Covenant and we bring food and give an offering to support North Raleigh Ministries, as our outreach and aid to our community continues on an ongoing basis. I


