### Joining Hands with God

When a doctoral student at Princeton asked, “What is there left in the world for original dissertation research?” Albert Einstein replied, “Find out about prayer. Somebody must find out about prayer.” Prayer may be the one most natural response of the human soul and yet the most mysterious action we undertake. We all speak of prayer, are moved when someone prays for us, and believe we should pray more. We many times in the church respond to a need we hear with those reassuring words “I will be praying for you.” However, we must admit that many times our intent to pray and our need to pray do not match our actual time spent in prayer.

At the heart of prayer is the realization of our need for God. As William James says, “The reason we pray is simply we cannot help praying.” There is something in our deepest being that reminds us that we are incomplete and we are in need of power beyond self. This is why prayer of some kind can be found in the most remote parts of the world and in every system in the world. We have a longing for something and in our case someone beyond self.

As Christians, we understand that our prayer is to God who is the One True God, the maker of heaven and earth. Yet, the person of Jesus also shapes our prayers. We do not simply pray to “a god” but to God who is defined by the life of Jesus. It is Jesus that teaches us to pray “Our Father.” It is Jesus who shows us and reminds us that God is good, gracious, forgiving and loving. It is Jesus that reminds us that God longs for us as we long for God. The Christian’s prayer life is altered and enriched through the example of Jesus. Thus, we pray in Jesus’ Name. We offer prayer to God, as one who is defined by Jesus, and we offer prayer to God so that God might transform us, so Jesus also defines us.

As followers of Jesus, we also are aware that prayer is both private and communal. It is true that each of us should pray privately. Jesus instructs us to go into our “closet” and pray. Prayer should not be a time for revealing our righteousness before others, but for a time of being humble before God. However, prayer is also communal in the New Testament. James reminds us to “confess our sins to each other and pray for each other.” James instructs us to call the elders of the church to pray over us in the name of Jesus in our time of need. Prayer is essential for the individual and for the community of faith.

This Sunday, we will be continuing in the book of James as we consider James’ instructions to pray. I hope you will join us as we consider the important topic of “Let us Pray.”

## Extended Teaching Care (ETC): How You Can Help

This tremendous ministry to preschoolers (Babies through Pre-K) takes place every Sunday during the 8:45am and the 11:00am worship hour. The 9:45am hour is already staffed by faithful, permanent teachers who serve every Sunday in Teaching God's Word in Sunday School. Each Wednesday night is another opportunity for the ETC ministry during 6:45 - 7:30pm.

ETC requires about 25-30 adult and youth volunteers each Sunday in eleven different classes. This requires over 350 volunteers based on serving once a quarter. Due to the large number of volunteers needed it has been a long-standing Trinity Baptist Church guiding principle that parents who have children in ETC are required to serve. Christian parents whose own children benefit from the teaching in ETC can be a blessing

to other children through this ministry. Dads are especially needed. Volunteers serve once a quarter with hopefully the same volunteers over time, you build a Christ-like relationship with the precious little ones and others in the church.

The preschoolers are counting on us to be responsible in our service to them and to God. Jesus said, "let the children come to me." We know they will never come to Him unless adults are willing to teach them. In ETC, you have a wonderful opportunity to minister to a great class of young boys and girls showing them the love of Jesus.

Many single adults and older adults, who have a heart for children, enjoy their time in ETC. Thank you parents for being responsible in this important area of ministry. Service is the highest calling for a Christian. "...children are a gift from God." Psalm 127:3

It is also our policy to conduct background checks on anyone who serves with children in any capacity. We seek to offer a safe and nurturing environment while you worship.
