This week you should have received our proposed budget for 2016, along with a letter from our Finance Committee concerning their recommendations. Our budget process is a long prayerful and thoughtful process. It involves our ministry and missions committees and ministerial staff making recommendations for ministry and program needs for the coming year. Our Finance Committee receives these requests and meets with committees and ministers as needed to discuss changes from last year's budget. The Finance Committee then begins the process of discerning priorities and our church's current giving trends and capacity. A budget is prepared by the Finance Committee and then submitted to our Trustees for questions and approval. Once this process is completed, it is then mailed to our congregation and will be presented in our regular Church Conference on October 18th at 7:00 p.m. in the Chapel.

This year, as a result of an action of the congregation, our voting process has been changed. The October 18th Church Conference will be the time for the budget to be presented and discussed. At the Church Conference, a time for any amendments will be considered. If there are no amendments proposed, the Church will vote on the budget in a special called Church Conference at the end of both services on October 25th. However, if any amendments are proposed there will be a special called Church Conference for the purpose of voting on those amendments on October 25th at 4:00 p.m. in the Chapel. The budget will then go to the Church on November 1st for approval at the end of each worship service.

Our budget is an important reflection of our ministry. Through our giving we are able to impact many lives here in Raleigh and around the world. Giving to our general budget each week through tithes and offerings not only provides the ministries that are important to our congregation each week, but through our missions cooperation we support Baptist work with colleges, hospitals, missionaries in the U.S and around the world. We support theological schools that are training the next generation of ministers, as well as creating opportunities for our own members to experience the joy of serving in our congregation and around the world. It is our giving that makes it possible for children to be cared for, nurtured and taught the lessons of the Bible. It is our giving that helps a student discover how to embrace his or her own faith in Jesus and make a difference in the world. It is through our giving that we can go in Jesus' name and show
