

- Take a walk outside and collect leaves, nuts and pinecones. Decorate your home with the items. Make a wreath, table centerpiece, or mantle display.
- Travel to an apple orchard, gather apples and make some applesauce, or apple pie.
- Watch a movie outside.
- Camp in the backyard or in the living room. Eat smore's and tell silly scary stories.
- Make mini honey drizzled tarts. Ingredients: Round cookie cutter, frozen puff pastry, 1-2 apples (cored, peeled, and sliced very thin), Cinnamon, sugar, honey, baking sheet, spatula, cooking rack.

Heat oven to 400 degrees. Line the baking sheet. Use the cookie cutter to cut rounds of pastry, and arrange them on the baking sheet. Have children place 3 apple slices on each pastry circle. When done, ask them to sprinkle each tart with a pinch of cinnamon sugar. Bake tarts until the pastry turns brown and the apples become slightly tender (about 12 min.) Drizzle honey on the baked tarts.
