This past Sunday evening, during our Church Conference, our 2016 budget was presented and after discussion there were no amendments offered. This means that this coming Sunday, October 25th, we will vote on our budget at the end of each of our morning worship services. Ballots will be provided for all church members present to vote a simple yes or no in approving our budget for next year. I want to thank our Finance Committee for all their hard work in creating a ministry budget that we believe meets our needs for ministry and missions and also exemplify good stewardship.

Our church continues to be healthy in regards to our stewardship due to several factors. First, our congregation continues to be obedient to God and generous in spirit. Your tithes and offerings are evidence of your discipleship. When we are obedient in tithing our income and giving of our resources two important blessings come to us. We are freed from the tyranny of greed and the pursuit of wealth. When we freely and generously give to God, we are reminded that God is God and money is not. We also discover the blessing of being part of something with an eternal purpose. If you are not tithing and giving to your church, I encourage you to discover the joy of giving to the Lord.

A second reason our church continues to be healthy financially is good stewardship. Our ministers and committees are mindful that the funds that are provided in our budget are gifts given to God. They seek to make good choices in how funds are spent and for what purpose they are spent. This is evident in that every year our budget is not spent. In addition, in budget preparation important conversations are had to determine what is necessary for this coming year and not simply what has been done in the past.

## **Laying the Foundation**

There is no more appropriate place for a child to learn to trust than in your family! Such security becomes the basis for learning to trust God and beginning to feel His love. Make sure your child understands that your home is safe and that the people there are caring ones.

Here are some specific ways to lay a foundation of secure feelings in babies:

- Respond. Don't ignore your baby or dismiss his or her crying or other behavior as "just crankiness." Make the effort to understand and help.
- Provide interesting things to do, to look at, and to listen to.
- Talk in a quiet, respectful and soothing way. Never respond in anger. Singing to your child may calm both of you. Or

Thank you for your effort to continue this ministry of worship. try talking to your child about how you want to respond gently and helpfully to his or her fussiness---singing may help you do that. Pray, asking God to give you gentle-ness in place of anger.

- Be observant. When you see trouble coming, distract your child with another activity or toy.
- Remove your child from danger or potential problems, talking to him or her as you do so will help your child understand what you are doing.
- Take time to watch your child, to ask and to respond in appropriate ways to him or her. This tells your little one he or she is important to you---and to God.
- Pray with your child.
- Sing or hum tunes of faith and assurance to your child.
- Talk about church as a positive and safe place to come.
- Speak positively about God and Jesus. Say often "Jesus loves you and so do I."

All that we do and say will lay a foundation of faith and trust in your young child. Be aware of Christ's presence in your own life and be open to talk about it with your children.
