Deacons - Our Deacons serve as care givers and spiritual leaders for the church. They give care to families in times of joy and sorrow. They also are asked to be on a Hospital Team or Homebound Team, ministering to those who are disconnected from the congregation by illness. In addition, they do outreach each month by contacting those whom they have been assigned and who have not attended. They also provide the senior pastor and church with spiritual direction.
