This coming Sunday we will have the opportunity to vote for the approval of our 2015 Church Budget. Our proposed budget is the result of much prayer, consideration and discernment. I am so grateful for the work of our committees, ministry leaders and in particular, our Finance Committee. The budget they have produced represents all that we value as a congregation. I am always reminded that every part of our budget is designed to enable us to minister to our community and world. We view the funds spent on facilities as much of a ministry as the funds we might spend on purchasing curriculum for Sunday School, sending people on mission or supporting our missionaries all over the world through our mission partners. There are some parts of the budget that are obvious when it comes to ministry and there are others that may not be as obvious, but each part allows us to minister effectively.

Our budget will contain funds for the spiritual education of our children, youth and adults. It will provide funds for our facilities that not only host our weekly activities, but welcomes mission partners like BSF, WHIN and Jobs For Life. We are constantly offering our facilities to Raleigh Baptist Association, Baptist State Convention of N.C. and the North Carolina Cooperative Baptist Fellowship. The opening of our building for use by community groups and individuals (ROC) are just some ways we use our facilities as a ministry.

In our budget, you will also find funds to support missionaries and you will find funds to support our own ministerial staff. These funds represent a commitment to support those who have been called by God to a particular purpose within the life of the church. We believe that we are all on mission no matter where God might be using us.

I share all of this to remind you that this budget is so much more than numbers of gifts and receipts. It truly represents our calling as a congregation to “join hands with God” in this world.

Remember, as we vote this week, we are not simply voting to approve this budget, but we also are committing ourselves to support our church and its mission. I want to thank you for continued faithful stewardship and challenge us all to make tithing and giving a part of our faithfulness to God.

My children and I visited Oak Hill Nursing Home in Angier, NC on Saturday to spend time with a very special lady named Mrs. Etheleen. She will turn 90 in January. This is a lady who is no biological kin to us, but a lady who reached out to us with love when we arrived in Raleigh in 1999. It doesn't seem that long ago my boys were picking grapes off her grapevine and eating them as she politely told them to leave enough grapes so she could make jelly. She always remembered my family's birthdays and made a special dessert on everyone's special day. She loved to hear Jeff and Sydney sing and when they sang, she smiled as a proud "grandmother" would.

I am thankful God placed her in our lives because she has been an example of a true servant of Christ. She has blessed my life in so many ways and my children's lives have been blessed. I don't just say this, I know it, because as we walked into her room and her eyes lit up, filled with tears, they embraced her with the love that she had always embraced them with. They love her and they recognize the gift of loving another human being outside of family. The first and greatest commandment from the Lord is to "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." And the second is "Love your neighbor as yourself."
