One of the opportunities and responsibilities of being in a Baptist church is the election of leadership. We do this throughout the year by voting to approve various committee members and ministry program leaders. Also, each year we are given the opportunity to elect new Deacons, Trustees, and Pastor Advisory Council Members. This process involves many dedicated people who give much of their time, prayer, and discernment. The process begins with our Church Council nominating a Deacon Nominating Committee from various age groups in the church to seek names for Deacon Nominations. Our standing Nominating Committee does the work of nominating names for Trustees and Pastor Advisory Council. These nominating committees do their work of prayer and discussion. Then they begin the process of contacting individuals to ask them to consider serving in these roles if elected by the congregation.

Each year, we seek to have approximately twice the number needed for election who are willing to have their names placed on the ballots for your consideration. This means that every year there are many who have said "yes I will serve" who do not get that opportunity to do so at this time. This can be disappointing and sometimes disheartening.
