Extended Teaching Care is a ministry of worship at Trinity. The committee is a team of 14 ladies that enlist and encourage at least 25-30 volunteers each week to care for our youngest during the two morning worship services. Many of the volunteers are parents. Many of them are middle age adults with children way past the age of extended care. And others are volunteers that are helpful adults just willing to serve and be used as God enables them to be.

We take all volunteers age 15 and up. We even allow younger youth to serve with a qualified adult. We will screen you and do a background check to protect you- the worker and the children.
