Deepen The Ties That Bind

As we come to the end of 2016, I have so many feelings about this past year. I am thankful to be a part of this great congregation. This past year has been a very important in the history of our church. When you are living through pivotal moments you don't normally realize how important they might be in the future. We embarked on an incredible challenge with the construction and renovation on our campus. This project has disrupted our programs, ministries and routines like none other in our history. The scope and length of the project is a great challenge to us. However, I am so proud of the way we have remained faithful during this time. I am grateful how we went through the process of our decision-making. Although we were not all in favor of the project, we were able to discern together God's will for us and make our decision. We did this remembering that the fellowship of our church and following God's will was the most important part of this process.

In our time of transition our spirit has been tremendous. We have embraced our transitional worship space in the ROC with enthusiasm. We have found new routines, places to sit and even discovered new people in the church that we did not even know attended worship at Trinity. Our ministries have learned to be flexible and nimble. Our Sunday School classes, Music Ministry, Recreation Ministry and Student Ministry have demonstrated a willingness to lead us in spirit and deed by moving from place to place over these past few months and have done so with grace and with keeping the purpose of ministry primary.

As a congregation we have demonstrated faithfulness in attendance, participation and giving. I am so grateful for everyone who has continued to make attending worship, giving to our budget and campaign a priority in their life. Thank you for demonstrating your love for our Lord and His church.

The beginning of 2017 will present us with our biggest test thus far in this process. As the new year begins we will face the "rolling shut down" of two of our education buildings. We will begin with Building B and then move to Building D as we prepare these buildings for the attachment to the new construction. These buildings will be shut down for an estimated 4 to 5 weeks (not at the same time) for the renovation to occur. This will again cause us to be flexible and be creative in space use.

I have always assumed that the first quarter of this year would be our most demanding of the process and so, I want to encourage you to continue to do what you have been doing. As we begin a new year, recommit yourself to following our Lord Jesus by being present
