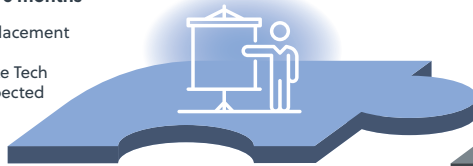

### PHASE 3 Genesis: 3-6 months

- Employment Preparation and Placement via "Jobs for Life"
- Career and Skills Training - Wake Tech
- Tutoring Children to Ensure Expected Grade Level Performance



### PHASE 6 18 months - 2+ years

- Home Ownership via Habitat for Humanity and Other Organizations
- Monthly Support for Long-Term Success



### PHASE 5 Transformation: 12-18 months

- Non-subsidized Apartment Placement
- Furnish Apartment - Thrift Store & Green Chair Project
- Weekly Support and Credit Counseling to Qualify for Homeownership.



### PHASE 4 Phoenix: 6-12 months

- Employed and Continues Wake Tech Training
- Purchases "Wheels for Hope" Car
- Connects with Volunteer Mentor
- Ready to Rent/Financial Planning Training
- Saves 4 months of Living Expenses for Phases 5 & 6.



### PHASE 2 Orientation: 30-90 days

- Develop Long-Term Plan for Stability
- Small Group Support (Lifeskills, Spiritual Development, Parenting, Recovery)
- Vocational Training/Opportunities
- Start Client Counseling & Tutoring
- Start Children's Counseling & Tutoring



### PHASE 1 Assessment 30 days

- Background Check
- Medical Assessment
- Mental Health Assessment
- Educational Assessment
- Assessment of Client's Children
- Vocational Training



## FY2019 KEY IMPACT METRICS

**382** adults and **180** children enrolled in the New Life Plan
