How to Teach Toddlers and Preschoolers to Pray



I want to continue talking about teaching our children to pray. Especially when we are talking about preschoolers it can be somewhat intimidating about where to begin. Here are a few ideas:

- Demonstrate for them how easy it is to talk to God – When a child of any age hears their parents talking to the God they believe it for themselves, it is already instilled in the child that simple talking is how we pray.
- Encourage your toddlers to pray with you – For example have them pray at your meals and at bedtime. You might not always understand the words, but you will love the demonstration of their growing faith of the God we serve.
- Introduce the stages of prayers – For example teach them how to be thankful for things such as: the food we eat, the

gifts we have and the gorgeous day. You know when your toddler or preschool has this one covered, because they want to thank God for everything and I do mean everything! You can also teach them to pray for healing by praying over their hurts, pain and illnesses. Teach them to pray for forgiveness, by helping them to pray when they are disobedient. Teach them to pray for others by sharing prayer requests, with them and praying together.

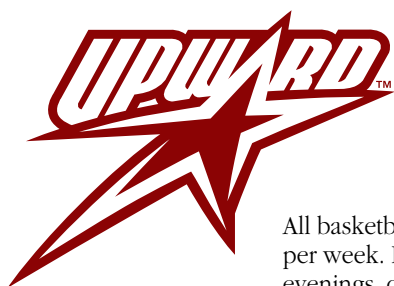
