

# Deepen The Ties That Bind

Dr. Tony Campolo once asked 50 people who were 95 years or older what they would do different if they could live their lives over again. They listed three regrets.

First they said they would spend more time in reflection. These elderly men and women wished they had spent more time thinking about their day and their actions and what it meant to their lives and in the grander scheme of God's activity. It is true we many times end our days after a full routine and never stop to reflect on how and where God is at work.

Second, they said they would take more risks. As those experienced in living looked back on lives their regrets were not what they attempted and failed but what they did not attempt in the first place. There are so many things in life that hold us back from taking risks. We tend to cling to that which is familiar and comfortable and resist new people and experiences. There is an old saying "you cannot follow Jesus and stand still." What step of faith is God calling you to this week?

Third, those who were polled said they would do more things that would last after they were dead. These elderly adults wanted to leave a legacy. They wished they had invested their time in people more than things. Jesus said "do not store up treasure on earth where things rot, rust and moths destroy but store up treasure in heaven where it is lasting. We need to be reminded that what we do for the Kingdom of God is what is eternally lasting.

This Sunday we turn our attention to the third question of our "Wilderness Questions." This question comes from Exodus 14 and it is a question of regret. Faced with the threat of Pharaoh's army on one side and the Red Sea on the other the Hebrews turn to Moses and say "What have you done to us by brining us out of Egypt? Didn't we say leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than die in the desert!"

These are words of regret. How do we live with regret and how do we avoid regret? That is our focus this week as we gather for worship. Our third question from the Wilderness is "What are we doing here?"

I hope you will join us as we gather for worship. I will be looking for you and anticipating what God is going to do when we gather together.
