I made the most important decision I would ever make when I was nine years old. It is true, since that time, I have made many other important decisions that have given my life a certain trajectory. However, a decision I made at just the age of nine has influenced all of these other decisions. At the age of 9, I asked God to forgive me of my sins and I accepted Jesus as my Lord and Savior. This decision was the result of a faith development that for me began at birth and now continues to this day. I was blessed to have parents, grandparents and others in my family who were followers of Jesus. Through the weekly discipline of prayer, Bible Study, and worship I was taught that following Jesus was a way of life.

One night, as I was preparing to go to bed, I mentioned to my father that I thought I was ready to make a decision to follow Jesus. My father stopped what he was doing and gave me his full attention. I am blessed because my Dad was prepared for this moment. He did not have to hesitate or even suggest we call the "preacher." Instead, he took his Bible and explained in a loving way what it meant to be "saved." We read some Bible verses and he explained them as we read. Then he asked me if I was ready to ask Jesus to be my Lord. I said, "yes". We both got on our knees by my bed and I asked Jesus to be my Lord and Savior and made the decision to follow Jesus. This moment is one of my greatest memories. As many of you know, my father passed away suddenly when he was 45 and I was only 17. I did not have many years or many memories with my Dad, but I often think if I only had this one it would be enough. For this one memory was an eternal decision and the most important moment in my life. This decision meant that even when my father passed away suddenly, my grief was filled with the hope that I would see him again as I will see Jesus.

I share this with you this week because I want Parents and Grandparents to be prepared to do what my father did with me. I want us as Parents to be confident when it comes to sharing our faith with our children and helping them to follow the Holy Spirit in their life. I want us as Parents and Grandparents to accept the responsibility of being the ones who lead our children to faith in Christ.

This coming Sunday night, February 12 at 6:00 p.m., we will be having a one night training for Parents and Grandparents. It is entitled "Kid's Faith." Rev. Karen Eickhoff and Katie Medlin will lead this important Discipleship Seminar. As ministers it is our responsibility to educate, inform and encourage you to be ready to share your faith. You will be glad you are prepared for those faith conversations to come.

Make Way for Play

Did you know that play is one of the most effective teaching methods for preschoolers? Younger preschoolers who are at play are actively doing. Older preschoolers at play are actively talking and doing. I came across a list this week that explains why play is so important for our children:

Children learn through their play. Don't underestimate the value of play. Children learn and develop:

cognitive skills – like math and problem solving in a pretend grocery store

physical abilities – like balancing blocks and running on the playground

new vocabulary – like the words they need to play with toy dinosaurs

social skills – like playing together in a pretend car wash

literacy skills – like creating a menu for a pretend restaurant

Play is healthy. Play helps children grow strong and healthy.

Play reduces stress. Play helps your children grow emotionally. It is joyful and provides an outlet for anxiety and stress.

Play is more than meets the eye. Play is simple and complex. There are many types of play: symbolic, sociodramatic, functional, and games with rules—to name just a few.

Make time for play. As parents, you are the biggest supporters of your children's learning. You can make sure they have as

much time to play as possible during the day to promote cognitive, language, physical, social, and emotional development.

Play and learning go hand-in-hand.

They are not separate activities. They are intertwined.

Play outside. Remember your own outdoor experiences of building forts, playing on the beach, sledding in the winter, or playing with other children in the neighborhood. Make sure your children create outdoor memories too.

There's a lot to learn about play. There's a lot written on children and play.

Trust your own playful instincts.

Remember as a child how play just came naturally? Give your children time for play and see all that they are capable of when given the opportunity.

Play is a child's context for learning.

Children practice and reinforce their learning in multiple areas during play. It gives them a place and a time for learning that cannot be achieved through completing a worksheet.
