Concepts a Child Needs to Have to Make a Profession of Faith

Have you ever thought about what one needs to know or feel secure about when making a decision to follow Christ the rest of their life? Eugene Chamberlain wrote a small book many decades ago titled: "When Can a Child Believe?" It laid a huge foundation for us in the children's faith business. Here are some of his thoughts.

The Bible offers only one plan of salvation. Many Bible students identify four major elements in this plan: Repent, Believe, Accept, and Confess. Check out these concepts a child needs to understand and be aware of when discovering faith and following Jesus the rest of his/her life.

- 1. God is my Creator.
- 2. God expects certain behavior from me.
- 3. I do some things that are not pleasing to God, but my overall behavior does not meet God's expectations.
- 4. I am so sorry that I do not meet God's expectations that I wish never again to displease Him.
- 5. I want God to forgive me for not meeting His expectations.

One of the joys of my ministry is to teach classes on helping children understand the process of becoming a church member at Trinity. The key element of this discussion is to understand what it means to accept Jesus as your Lord and Savior and become a Christian. This is first and foremost in our lessons. I have listed some concepts that Eugene Chamberlain shared many years ago which are still relevant today. I do not teach these concepts in any order. But I share them in this newsletter for parents or others to know as a guide when questions arise.

I also like to emphasize that there is no quick alliterated plan for becoming a Christian. It is not a simple memorizing chart that leads one to an eternal relationship with our Lord. It is a day-by-day walk through prayer that establishes this relationship and continues one's faith experience. Be wary of providing your child with a false sense of security. Rather encourage the relationship and get down on your knees with them before the Father. Make their prayer exactly that. Theirs alone. Only they can establish the relationship with Jesus. We can only watch and pray.
