

TBC has been involved in JfL since 2007. Our faithful Lead Team has completed 17 classes with 110 graduates! We've seen around 80 different volunteers involved in this mission.

Jobs for Life is a Raleigh-based international organization that pursues its mission and vision by mobilizing churches to reach out to the unemployed/underemployed and equip them to better succeed in the workplace. Each JfL church provides biblical instruction, job training, coaching and personal support to their city's neediest citizens, helping lift them from dependency to self-sufficiency as a part of God's purpose for meaningful work.


