Deepen The Ties That Bind

This past Sunday, you received a bulletin insert that introduced you to a new approach to ministry on Sunday evenings beginning this fall. As we have done in the past, there will be some ministries to our church and community that will continue. Our ministry to preschoolers, children and students will also remain in tact. However, our ministry with adults on Sunday nights is taking a new focus for this coming year.

What the church should be doing and offering on Sunday nights has been a part of discussion at Trinity for many years. When I arrived in 2000, we had a very active Sunday night program filled with Discipleship Training and Evening Worship. Over the years, as our culture has changed we have seen Sunday evening become a time which is guarded by many families and individuals. Over that same time period Sunday evenings here at Trinity have become a smorgasbord of discipleship, worship and fellowship. All of this has been good since all three of those ministries support our core values.

This past year, our ministerial staff began to ask the question of why should we have Sunday night programs. Is it just because we have always had something on Sunday night? Is it because we believed that the church desired to be together? Is it because there was something unique we could do on Sunday night that we could not do at other times as a congregation? After much discussion and prayer we began to ask the question of what could make Sunday night unique. What could we do on Sunday night that we could not do at other times during the week? We became convinced that Sunday night presented a unique opportunity to not only gather together but to go and serve our community. Although we serve our community in many capacities, we wanted to design a time during our normal church activities that would encourage us to become aware of ministering to and caring for those around us.

Toward this goal we have developed a ministry schedule on Sunday evenings for the year that encourages us to discover needs around us and to reach out to our community. We have entitled this time "Being the Presence of Christ." We have divided the year into four five-week segments. During the five-week segments, we will spend time both gathering and going. During each of the five week segments we spend some evenings being educated by guests on a certain topic or opportunity. Then on other nights, we will be off campus responding to what we have learned.

As an example, our first five-week segment begins on September 10th with the topic of "Being the Presence of Christ in our Community." This topic will include three gathering nights and two going nights. We will hear from Chris Ally of the North Carolina Baptist State Convention regarding demographics of who are our neighbors around Trinity and the challenge to sharing the gospel. We will also hear from Mike Smith who is President and Chief Operating Officer with Kane Realty. Mike will be sharing with us about development in North Hills and also where he believes the church can make a difference in community here in Midtown. We will also have two going nights. One will be a prayer walk through our neighborhood around the church. The second one will be a time of gathering in North Hills for dinner or dessert on a Sunday evening. There you will be encouraged to pray for those around you and to take notice of those in our community. You will be encouraged to "be the presence of Christ."

This is just an example of what we are trying to attempt to do. We want us to begin thinking about not only gathering on our campus, but being the church away from the campus. We also believe this ministry is something everyone of every age can do and we encourage you to, even now, begin to think how you can be a part of this first five-week segment.

Until we arrive in September, I want you to be praying for this new endeavor. We truly do not want it to be simply another thing to do at church on Sunday night. We want it to be an opportunity for us to grow spiritually and to experience what it means to be a gathering and going church. I hope you will pray with me for this new ministry endeavor and consider how you can be a part.

A Marriage Enrichment Group (MEG) is an ongoing small group that provides a safe place for married or engaged couples to explore their relationship among supportive peers. Each MEG is as unique as the couples in them! All couples are there to strengthen and grow their relationship and have fun doing it.

The MEG purpose is to build skills toward enriching four things that will encourage a healthy marriage relationship: A Commitment to Growth, An Effective Communication System, The Creative Use of Conflict, and Frequent Expressions of Affection and Affirmation.

MEGs at TBC meet once a month. The “First Year” group will meet the 2nd Friday of each month during the school year in the Underground. “Ongoing” groups (alumnae) meet in a home with up to 10 couples including a Leader Couple. Each month the MEGs will address a different topic from a book they read together. The goal of the couples' time together is to focus on their relationship. There is some social time in the schedule with the majority of the time is spent with couples dialoguing about the topic of the week as it concerns their relationship.
