### Deepen The Ties That Bind

Don't you love church? Those were my words as we ended our time together this past Sunday evening. We had gathered for a meal in the Fellowship Hall. We had heard about our church's work in Ukraine, McCreary County, Kentucky and Belize. We had celebrated what God is doing in and through our congregation. In addition, we held our monthly Church Conference, which is the time for the congregation to hear reports from committees, make recommendations, learn about our financial health, approve our leadership and celebrate what God is doing. As I shared with you last week in my newsletter article, our Trustees have made two recommendations to our congregation. Last night in Church Conference the following actions were taken:

- 1. The Church approved the use of the excess of funds (gifts over expenses) in 2016 to be used toward the repaying of all of the parking lot with the exclusion of the north parking lot around Building E. This will be completed after construction is complete.
- 2. The Church also voted to hold a "Special Called Church Conference" on Sunday, September 10, to vote on allowing the Trustees to raise our permanent loan after construction from \$3.5 to \$4 million if needed. The purpose of this potential raise in our loan cap is to allow the Trustees and Building and Grounds Committee to include the re-roofing of Buildings A, B and older part of C as a part of the construction project. Because our By-Laws identify borrowing funds as a major church event, this vote will be taken at the end of worship in both services on September 10.

There are several reasons for the rationale of allowing this raise to the permanent loan if needed. First, our Maintenance Coordinator and our Building and Grounds Committee report that the roofs need to be replaced. Some of them are more critical than others, but all are projected for replacement in the next few years. Second, the cost of the roof repair and replacement is estimated at \$350,000. Because our current construction loan allows us to borrow more than the \$3.5 million cap the Church has approved, we have access to funds now at a very low inter-

est rate. These funds will not be available if we choose to replace the roofs at a later date. When we finish our construction at the end of this year and receive our Certificate of Occupation, we have to transition from our construction loan to a permanent loan. Once we move to the permanent loan, the extra funds for the roof replacement will not be available. The Trustees also believe that this is a matter of timing more than financial resources available. If we as a congregation fulfill our pledges and others continue to give unpledged amounts, we hope and project that the permanent loan will ultimately not have to be raised. However, this is only something we will know at the end of the year, and to include the re-roofing, we need to act in the next few months.

The really good news is that even if we have to raise the permanent loan to \$4 million, the mortgage payment that is currently in our 2017 budget is more than enough to meet our obligation. Thus, this would require no raise in our yearly budget.

I want to thank all who were present at Church Conference to hear this recommendation and make recommendations. I deeply appreciate our Trustees, Finance Committee, Construction Committee, Building and Grounds Committee and Treasurer for their hard work in helping us seek to be good stewards of our financial resources and our campus. We have such incredible wise leadership in our congregation.

If you have any questions regarding this, please do not hesitate to speak to one of our Trustees. This newsletter will serve as the official calling of a Special Church Conference for September 10 in accordance to our By-Laws.
