# Deepen The Ties That Bind

This past Sunday, we voted in a Special Church Conference by 96% in favor to authorize the Trustees to raise our permanent loan cap after construction to 4 million dollars, if needed. I am thankful for all who participated. As we began the construction phase of our project, we had set our limit at 3.5 million dollars. However, in the past few months it has become evident, through the work of our Building and Grounds Committee and our Construction Team, that there were some capital needs in buildings that are not connected to our new construction. These include roof replacement of buildings A, B and existing C. In addition, a small roof construction project is needed on building A to fix a design flaw that is causing water to enter the building. The Trustees, after hearing these reports, believed the best solution was to address these needs as we are bringing our construction to a finish.

It is important to know a few facts as we move forward. First, the loan cap that we have set is of our own initiative. The bank offered a much larger loan cap but we, as a congregation, have sought to be good stewards through this process. Second, our current mortgage payment that is included in the 2016 budget (we have been paying ourselves a mortgage payment since we paid off Buildings A and the ROC) is more than enough to meet the need of a 4 million dollar mortgage payment once construction is completed. Third, our Construction Team has done a tremendous job and our project is currently on budget for completion. Fourth, if we as a congregation complete the pledges we have made toward our project, it is estimated that the need for a raise in the cap will not be needed.

So, what can we all do as we move into this final phase of construction and look forward to being back in our sanctuary and in our new facility? First, if you made a pledge, please do your best to complete it in this coming year. If you cannot complete it by the end of the year, please consider completing it as you can. Second, if you did not pledge, but you would like to be a part of what your church is doing in regards to our new facility, consider making a pledge, or you can just give toward the project. We have received almost \$400,000 in un-pledged gifts to date. That is tremendous. Third, you may have already completed your pledge but you want to help with this additional capital need. Consider making another gift toward the project. Lastly, continue to pray for our church, be good and cheerful givers to our project but also to our ministry budget and rejoice in all that God is doing and preparing for us in the future.

I am looking forward to our "Being the Presence of Christ" session this coming Sunday evening. We will have as our guest Cris Ally of the North Carolina Baptist State Convention. Cris is a former missionary to China and has returned home to North Carolina to help


