Deepen The Ties That Bind

In his book "Too Busy Not To Pray, "Bill Hybels writes, "Prayer has not always been my strong suit. For many years, even as senior pastor of a large church, I knew more about prayer than I ever practiced in my own life. I have a racehorse temperament, and the tugs of self-sufficiency and self-reliance are very real to me. I didn't want to get off the fast track long enough to find out what prayer is all about."

When I read Bill Hybels words they ring true to me as well. I suspect that there are many in our congregation that also could express Rev. Hybels' sentiment concerning prayer. Over the past 17 years, what I have noticed about our congregation is we are "doers." We respond to tasks and we enjoy the hands-on moments of ministry. Whether it is a mission trip, serving the homeless, working at North Raleigh Ministries or building a wheelchair ramp, we are workers and doers. I am afraid that for many of us, prayer is not viewed as action but a lack of action. However, I am discovering what I have known for many years; prayer is a powerful action and without it, all of our action can lead to nothing.

Cris Ally reminded us this past Sunday night in our session on "Being the Presence of Christ," that salvation is a miracle. Sharing the gospel with our changing community will not simply be our task but it is God's work. In fact, without the movement of the Spirit of God, the lives of those who are coming to our community will not be transformed. This is why prayer is such an important part of being the presence of Christ in our community.

This coming Sunday evening I invite you to be active in prayer for our community. On Sunday evenings we have designed an experience of coming and of going around the theme of being the presence of Christ. This coming Sunday night is a going night. You are invited to come and be a part of an active prayer time. We will be going on a prayer walk in our neighborhood and community. We will give you instructions on where to go and what to do as you take a leisurely walk around our congregation. If for some reason you are unable to walk, we will give you an opportunity to stay here at the church and pray to go to certain areas of our community and pray.

Why is this prayer time important? It is important because without the power of God, our congregation has nothing of importance to offer to our community. It is important because it allows us to humble our self and confess that we are part of God's work and not that God is "part" of our work. It is important because we believe that prayer is effective and can change our lives and the lives of others.

For all of these reasons I am encouraging you to join us this Sunday night at 6:00 p.m. in the Chapel and be a part of this experience. This is something you can do with friends and/or your family. We encourage families to come and bring their children and use this time as a family ministry opportunity. I am looking forward to this time together.

Since our last blood drive at TBC we have had two major disasters in Hurricanes Harvey and Irma. The Red Cross is a vital partner with Southern Baptist's Disaster Relief in both of these situations. They do so much more than provide blood to patients who need it. But in the midst of these situations, the need for blood is even greater for two reasons: 1) injuries from the storms, 2) scheduled blood drives in the disaster areas cancelled.

Recovery Unit 2 arrived on Thursday (14th). Additional volunteers arrive tomorrow also to help prepare the staging area site and equipment for helping those affected by Hurricane Irma.
