

EASTERN NC - Trinity is still working in the Lumberton area to help do finishing work on homes damaged by Hurricane Matthew ('16) and are almost ready for the families to move back in. We had a very successful trip in September. Next scheduled mission:

TEXAS - Currently we are preparing approximately 9,500 meals/day on Manna One Feeding Unit, serving in the Nederland and Port Arthur areas. In addition, we have over 130 homes to clean out from the flooding. More volunteers are needed. **Sign up at www.baptistsonmission.org/hurricaneharvey.**

FLORIDA - Feeding Unit 2 (30,000/meals per day) is set up in South Miami and is providing hurricane victims with meals from S. Miami down through the Keys. They also have a drinking water tanker and additional support equipment and teams. Recovery Unit 2 and other volunteers are preparing the staging area site and equipment for helping those affected by Hurricane Irma. Recovery Volunteers will be called up shortly
